### **Two-Syllable Words (VC/CV Pattern)**

Divide between two consonants (VC/CV), both syllables are closed.

Words with blends or digraphs that affect division.

## Four-Syllable Words (Primarily Closed Syllables)

Primarily closed syllables; some exceptions depending on regional pronunciation.

2. mathematical → math/e/mat/i/cal

3. accidental → ac/ci/den/tal

4. fundamental → fun/da/men/tal

5. instrumental → in/stru/men/tal

6. continental → con/ti/nen/tal

7. confidential → con/fi/den/tial

8. transactional → trans/ac/tion/al

9. environmental → en/vi/ron/men/tal

10. confrontational → con/fron/ta/tion/al

11. constitutional → con/sti/tu/tion/al

12. developmental → de/vel/op/men/tal
13. confrontational → con/fron/ta/tion/al
14. implementation → im/ple/men/ta/tion
15. organizational → or/gan/iz/a/tion/al
16. educational → ed/u/ca/tion/al (has both closed and open)
